Steps to Entering Program

- 3. Obtain a list of DC 1M signatory glazing contractors.
- 4. Apply and gain employment with a DC 1M signatory contractor.
- 5. Be initiated in a Local Union Affiliated with The District Council # 1M.
- 6. Sign up and start attending the Finishing Trades Institute of the Great Lakes.
